In writing *Patris Corde* (With a Father's Heart) Pope Francis wanted us all to increase our love for this great Saint, to encourage us to implore his intercession and to imitate his virtues and his zeal. As well as asking the Saints to obtain miracles and graces for us, we ask them to pray for us before God. The Saints are given to us as examples of holiness, examples to imitate, and who prove to us that it is possible to put the values of the Gospel into practice. Perhaps it was the example of St Joseph which encouraged Jesus to be "...gentle and humble in heart..." What St Joseph and all the Saints have done, we can do now too. During this Year of St Joseph, we're invited to ask him to help us to be and stay close to Jesus.
